We write with respect to the news article entitled "Semirara to hike output" posted in Inquirer.net on June 14, 2016. The article reported in part that:

"Semirara Mining and Power Corp. (SMPC) may increase coal production by a fourth this year assuming normalized operations and the initial impact of expansion work at its coal mine site in Antique.

SMPC CEO Isidro A. Consunji said in a text message that SMPC's production could recover to about 10 million metric tons (MT) for 2016, or 25.31 percent more than the output last year. That is, given favorable weather conditions for maximized operating days and the initial production from the Molave pit of the mine site.

Overburden stripping (removing the top layer of rock and soil to expose the ore) is ongoing at the Molave coal mine.

Coal production is expected to start there by August or September.

In view of the foregoing, we wish to confirm subject to certain clarification as follows:

1. SMPC's production could reach to about 10 million metric tons (MT) for 2016 given favorable weather conditions for maximized operating days and the initial production from the Molave pit of the mine site.
2. Overburden stripping ongoing (removing the top layer of rock and soil to expose the ore) and coal production estimated to begin by September 2016.
