

SMPC's expansion is in line with the commissioning and commercial operations of new coal plants during the year and the scheduled capacity expansion of cement plants.

Over 3,500 people work in SMPC's mining operations, of which approximately 17 percent are skilled workers locally sourced from STCI.

Enrollment is open not only to local residents of Semirara Island, but to residents from nearby islands such as Caluya and Sibay.

Tuition fees and other school fees for technical materials, tools, and projects are waived for students who are Semirara residents and those from nearby islands. STCI scholars from Mindanao are also provided with accommodation and meals for their entire stay.
